Commonly symptoms:

- Fatigue
- Difficulty concentrating
- Anger or irritability
- Trouble with sleeping
- Muscle tension
- Headaches
- Stomach aches
- Nervousness, or being on edge

How to Help:

- Recognize the Signs
- Don't dismiss it
- Talk to them or encourage them to seek someone they trust
- **LISTEN!!**
- Ensure you get adequate rest and healthy meals while camping
- Provide a safe environment
